The Rolling Thunder® WI 3 Scholarship will be a one-time award of \$500.00 and will be payable after the first semester, upon presenting first semester transcripts and proof of enrollment for the following semester. This award will be made payable to the institution that the recipient is attending, and will be sent directly to the institution.

To be eligible for this scholarship you must be a high school graduate and a full-time student at an accredited technical college, college or university.

You must be a U.S. Citizen, a Wisconsin resident, and a descendent or child of a U.S. Military service veteran who was killed while in the line of duty, or who passed away as a result of being in the line of duty, between the Viet Nam war and the present.

You must have a minimum 2.50 cumulative Grade Point Average.
