Bill, Wisconsin Veteran Student Assistance Grant, Professional/Occupational License Fee Waiver, DNR Returning Service Members Voucher, Veteran-Owned Business Certification, Veterans Assistance Grant, Retraining Grant, Veterans Education (VetEd) Grant, Veterans Employment Grant, County Veterans Service Office (CVSO) Grant, Tribal Veterans Service Office (TVSO) Grant, Veteran Service Organization (VSO) Grant, Entrepreneurship Grant, Nonprofit Grant, and Pre-Registration for Cemetery Interment.
