We are a skilled nursing facility providing:

Because the VA subsidizes part of a qualified veteran's cost to live at the Wisconsin Veterans Home, daily out-of-pocket rates for the qualified veteran are well below average and include the cost of medications.

Although it is not a requirement to have a service-connected disability to reside at King, did you know the Federal Veterans Administration may pay the majority of the cost for nursing home care for veterans who meet any of the following criteria?*

We also welcome qualified non-Wisconsin residents.

1. Your needed nursing home care is directly related to a service-connected disability.
2. You are rated at least 70 percent disabled due to service-connected disability or disabilities.
3. You have a total disability rating based on individual unemployability (TDIU).
