**Wisconsin Department of Veterans Affairs and the Milwaukee Brewers
"team up" to support veterans**

Brewers recognize veterans in support of the "Mission: Welcome Home" initiative

(MADISON) – As a way to pay tribute to the men and women serving in the United States Armed Forces, the Milwaukee Brewers have created "Stars and Stripes Sundays." Each Sunday at Miller Park during the 2005 season, the Brewers are offering two FREE Terrace Level tickets to active and retired military personnel. The offer applies to all branches of the military service. Active and retired military personnel must present valid military identification which entitles them to two FREE Terrace Level tickets redeemable at windows 7-12 at Miller Park on the day of the game only. The offer is based on ticket availability.

On one Sunday each month, the Brewers and the Wisconsin Department of Veterans Affairs (WDVA) will recognize returning veterans in the "Mission: Welcome Home" project. The WDVA has identified the Marine Corps as the branch of the military for honor at Miller Park on Sunday April 17. The units in attendance who will be honored are: Golf Company 2nd Battalion 24th Marine Regiment (Golf 2/24) and Fox Company 2nd Battalion 24th Marine Regiment (Fox 2/24).
