- Establish eligibility for state veterans benefits (bring your DD form 214);
- Apply for benefits such as VA health care, VA compensation and pension claims, education and job training grants, personal loans, home improvement loans, and home mortgage loans;
- Receive information on and attend briefings provided throughout the day on state and federal benefits;
- Get help in obtaining military medals and records;
- Find out about employment and education opportunities;
- Obtain information about nursing home care and aging services;
- Preregister for burial in state veterans' cemeteries;
- Learn about veterans assistance for small businesses;
- Receive feedback from the IRS, Department of Revenue, Social Security Administration, and Department of Transportation (veteran license plates);
- Access military retiree information;
- Free admission, free refreshments, and free parking.
