## WOMEN VETERANS PROGRAM

The Women Veterans' Program, Wisconsin Department of Veterans Affairs (WDVA) was established in 1999 with the appointment of the state's first Women Veterans Coordinator. The Women Veterans Coordinator is responsible for addressing the needs of women veterans in our state. The WDVA remains committed to:

- Providing advocacy for women veterans;
- Encouraging and supporting recognition of women veterans' contributions to Wisconsin and the nation;
- Providing outreach for women veterans' programs and issues;
- Uniting Wisconsin women veterans so their voices may be heard.

As of 2007, WDVA has a Women Veterans Coordinating Committee. The mission of the Committee is to plan, set-up, and run the annual women veteran's conference; and to identify the needs of women veterans in Wisconsin as to health care, mental health care, federal and state benefits, economic success, and outreach.

## VETERANS BENEFITS

Here is a list of some of the benefits that may be available to you.

**Federal:** Home Loan Guarantee, Education Benefits, Compensation and Pension Benefits, Vocational Rehabilitation, Health Care, Funeral Honors, Burial. **State of Wisconsin:** Education Benefits, Home Loan, Home Improvement Loan, Personal Loan, Assistance to the Needy, Federal Claims Assistance, Review of Military Discharges, Veterans Assistance Program, Nursing Home Care, State Veterans Cemeteries. ## DATABASE OF WOMEN VETERANS

The Women Veterans Coordinator has a database listing women veterans in Wisconsin. This database is used to send out information to women veterans. Plus the Coordinator has an e-mail list of women veterans. These databases are strictly confidential. The e-mail list is used to send out various stories regarding women veterans, women in the military; forwarding e-mails from other women veterans or sources that may be of interest to everyone; plus information that is mailed out to the women veterans. Only about 6% of all women veterans are listed on these two databases.
